About Stand for Her Land

Land is the foundation for shelter, livelihood, and climate resilience. Land is fundamental for survival. Because land is central to power and identity, control over land is fundamental to gender justice. But despite enormous recent progress to ensure women's equal legal rights to land, housing, property, territory, and natural resources (WLR), we are still far from achieving equality in practice. We cannot achieve gender equality without women's equal rights to and control over the world's most elemental resources.

Stand for Her Land (S4HL) is a global advocacy initiative working to close the "implementation gap" for WLR: the gulf between the strong laws, policies, and standards already in place to protect women's rights to land from international to national levels, and the recognition of those rights in practice at the local level.
